Short Title: House Dist. 6 Public Service Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR LOCAL PUBLIC SERVICE PROJECTS
IN THE SIXTH HOUSE DISTRICT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin County the sum of \$6,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be allocated equally among the fire departments in Martin County listed below:

- (1) Bear Grass Fire Department;
- (2) Griffin Township Fire Department;
- (3) Jamesville Fire Department; and
- (4) Williamston Fire Department.

These funds shall be used for operating expenses and to purchase equipment.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bertie County the sum of \$6,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be allocated equally among the fire departments in Bertie County listed below:

- (1) Perrytown Fire Department;
- (2) Trap Fire Department;
- (3) Aulander Fire Department;
- (4) Colerain Fire Department;
- (5) Powellsville Fire Department; and
- (6) Windsor Fire Department.

These funds shall be used for operating expenses and to purchase equipment.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Ahoskie Chamber of Commerce, Inc., in Hertford County the sum of \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to

1 support its efforts in creating an environment that is conducive to attracting business
2 and industry to this economically deprived area of the State.

3 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin Community
4 Players, Inc., in Martin County the sum of \$3,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist in
5 operating expenses and production costs of its shows and programs that enrich the entire
6 community.

7 Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin Community
8 Action, Inc., in Martin County the sum of \$3,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to help
9 support its Head Start Program.

10 Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin County the
11 sum of \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the Martin County Youth Center to
12 continue its public service programs.

13 Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Bethel in
14 Pitt County the sum of \$1,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the Bethel Rescue Squad
15 to use for operating expenses and to purchase equipment.

16 Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin County the
17 sum of \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the Martin County Red Cross to continue
18 the services and programs that are available to the public.

19 Sec. 9. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of
20 Jamesville in Martin County the sum of \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the
21 town's historic restoration projects.

22 Sec. 10. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin County the
23 sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the county's Agricultural Extension
24 Service to use to continue the 4-H program.

25 Sec. 11. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bertie County the
26 sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the county's Agricultural Extension
27 Service to continue the area's 4-H program.

28 Sec. 12. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Ahoskie Rescue
29 Squad, Inc., in Hertford County the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for
30 operating expenses and to purchase equipment.

31 Sec. 13. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of
32 Everetts in Martin County the sum of \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for public local
33 development projects.

34 Sec. 14. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Bear
35 Grass in Martin County the sum of \$3,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for its Clean
36 Water Fund.

37 Sec. 15. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of
38 Ahoskie in Hertford County the sum of \$3,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the
39 recreation department to use to continue its programs that are available to the public.

40 Sec. 16. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
