- Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin Community Action, Inc., in Martin County the sum of \$3,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to help support its Head Start Program.
- Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin County the sum of \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the Martin County Youth Center to continue its public service programs.
- Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Bethel in Pitt County the sum of \$1,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the Bethel Rescue Squad to use for operating expenses and to purchase equipment.
- Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Martin County the sum of \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the Martin County Red Cross to continue the services and programs that are available to the public.
- Sec. 9. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Jamesville in Martin County the sum of \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the town's historic restoration projects.
