A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ORGANIZATIONS IN CRAVEN,
2 PAMLICO, AND LENOIR COUNTIES FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Craven County the
5 sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for capital projects of the YMCA that will
6 benefit the entire New Bern community.

7 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to United Tri-County
8 Senior Citizens Corporation, Incorporated, the sum of \$3,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year
9 to supplement local funds for program activities for the elderly.

10 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Harvey Gardens of
11 Kinston, Inc., the sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to continue its program of
12 improving community parks.

13 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Pamlico County the
14 sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist the Pamlico Boosters Club with
15 athletic programs.

16 Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Craven County the
17 sum of \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used at the county's discretion for
18 county projects.

19 Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Big Brother/Big
20 Sister of the Lower Neuse the sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for expanding
21 its programs and services to youths.

22 Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Havelock
23 Communities Improvement Association, in Craven County, the sum of \$2,000 for the

1 1989-90 fiscal year for renovation of the community building in the Harlowe
2 community.

3 Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the General Fund to SAFE in Lenoir
4 County, Inc., the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist victims of domestic
5 violence.

6 Sec. 9. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Lenoir County
7 Historical Association, Inc., the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for
8 restoration of the Archdell House and Museum.

9 Sec. 10. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Eastern Minority
10 Economic Development Corporation the sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for
11 economic workshops to promote the development of small businesses.

12 Sec. 11. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Vanceboro
13 Community Organization, Incorporated, the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year
14 for operating expenses of its community programs.

15 Sec. 12. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Pamlico County
16 Firemen's Association, Incorporated, \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to purchase
17 pagers to ensure greater fire protection.

18 Sec. 13. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Pamlico County the
19 sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist the Pamlico Senior Services in
20 purchasing a van to transport senior citizens.

21 Sec. 14. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Lenoir County
22 \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used at the county's discretion for community
23 projects.

24 Sec. 15. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Craven County
25 Council on Aging, Inc., \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to renovate the community
26 building.

27 Sec. 16. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Bridgeton
28 Volunteer Fire Department No. 1 \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to purchase
29 equipment to provide better fire protection.

30 Sec. 17. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Craven County
31 Council on Women, Inc., \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to support and expand its
32 programs for victims of sexual assault and to assist in strengthening other programs.

33 Sec. 18. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Lenoir County
34 \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used by the Community Council for the Arts to
35 renovate the Community Arts Center.

36 Sec. 19. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Pamlico Players
37 \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to renovate the old theatre for arts programs.

38 Sec. 20. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Eastern Carolina
39 Exchange/Exchangette Child Abuse Prevention Center, Inc., \$2,000 for the 1989-90
40 fiscal year for its child abuse center.

41 Sec. 21. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
