A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND EXPANSION OF FACILITIES IN THE SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURE AT 3 4 NORTH CAROLINA A & T STATE UNIVERSITY. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of 6 Governors of The University of North Carolina for the School of Agriculture at North 7 Carolina A & T State University the sum of \$9,920,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be 8 9 allocated as follows: 10 \$4,000,000 to acquire land and to construct a small farm (1) demonstration center that will enable the university to conduct on-site 11 training for paraprofessional agricultural extension workers, 12 provide a test site for trial farming systems, and to conduct 13 demonstrations of certain techniques thus increasing the awareness of 14 15 opportunities for profitable alternative farm-based enterprises. \$2,200,000 for renovations and improvements to Carver Hall, a major 16 (2) facility for agricultural research and instruction used on a year-round 17 basis. 18 19 **(3)** \$250,000 to renovate and convert space in Ward Hall into labs that

may be used to conduct research in food safety.
