A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A FIRE
TRAINING BUILDING IN CRAVEN COUNTY.

Whereas, Craven County has a county-wide volunteer fire department with only two paid chiefs; and

Whereas, Craven County receives 1,300 fire alarms per year; and

Whereas, specialized training is needed to provide adequate fire protection in rural areas; and

Whereas, no eastern facility exists for specialized training in live fire burning and smoking houses; and

Whereas, members of the Craven County Firemans Association, Inc., have to travel to Durham or Raleigh to receive this specialized training; and

Whereas, Craven County desperately needs a fire training building to be used to train its fire fighters in live fire burning and smoking houses to ensure adequate fire protection; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Craven County the sum of \$50,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for construction of a fire training building to be used to train all members of the Craven County Firemans Association, Inc. This appropriation shall be matched with non-State funds on the basis of \$1.00 of non-State funds for every \$2.00 of State funds.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
