A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS ON OR ACROSS ANY  
HIGHWAY IN WATAUGA COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 13 of the 1977 Session Laws reads as  
rewritten:

**Section 1.** It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, take or kill any species of  
wild animal or wild bird by the use of any loaded firearm or other lethal weapon from  
the roadway or right-of-way of any State-maintained road or highway, or to discharge a  
firearm or other lethal weapon across any such road or highway in Ashe ~~County~~ and  
Watauga Counties."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1990.
