A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO OPERATE THE UNIFORM EDUCATION REPORTING SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education the sum of \$2,859,664 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to operate the Uniform Education Reporting System. Of these funds, the Department shall use the sum of \$2,421,022 as a contribution to local school administrative units for covering essential costs involved in the operation of the business management systems of the Uniform Education Reporting System as mandated in G.S. 115C-12(18), including hardware maintenance, software enhancements, paper and other supplies, communications with the State, and personnel training. The Department shall use the remaining \$438,642 to reimburse 13 local school administrative units for expenses incurred in converting to AS/400 equipment as required to implement the Uniform Education Reporting System.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
