AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OLD BALDY LIGHTHOUSE ON
BALD HEAD ISLAND.  Whereas lighthouses have played an important role in maritime history; and
Whereas, lighthouses have played an important role in maritime history; and Whereas, Bald Head Island served as the site for the first lighthouse in North
Carolina to be funded by the federal government in 1792; and
Whereas, the Old Baldy Lighthouse on Bald Head Island was built in 1817
and is the oldest lighthouse in North Carolina; and
Whereas, the Old Baldy Lighthouse is in need of repairs to preserve its
historical significance; Now, therefore,
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Old Baldy
Foundation, Inc., in Brunswick County the sum of \$25,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year
for renovation and preservation of the Old Baldy Lighthouse on Bald Head Island.
Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
