2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE DOMICILIARY HOME RATES AND TO 3 APPROPRIATE FUNDS.

- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. Section 81 of Chapter 500 of the 1989 Session Laws, as rewritten 6 by Section 131 of Chapter 752 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 81. Effective January 1, 1990, the maximum monthly rate for ambulatory 7 residents in domiciliary care facilities shall be seven hundred twenty-four dollars 8 (\$724.00) \$724.00 and the maximum monthly rate for semi-ambulatory residents shall 9 be seven hundred sixty dollars (\$760.00) \$760.00. Effective January 1, 1991, the 10 maximum monthly rates for ambulatory residents shall be increased to seven hundred 11 thirty-four dollars (\$734.00) \$830.00 and for semi-ambulatory residents seven hundred 12 seventy dollars (\$770.00) \$866.00." 13 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social 14

- 15 Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of \$4,920,895 for the 1990-91 16 fiscal year, to fund the State share of the cost of this act.
- 17 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
