A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE MATCHING REQUIREMENT FOR FUNDS
PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR THE LATHAM HOUSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 20 of Chapter 778 of the 1985 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"Sec. 20. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of ten thousand dollars
(\$10,000) for fiscal year 1985-86 to assist in the adaptive restoration of the Latham
House. ~~House in Plymouth, provided a like amount of non-State funds is raised by the Latham
Foundation to match this appropriation on a dollar-for-dollar basis."~~

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
