A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE DOMICILIARY HOME RATES AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 81 of Chapter 500 of the 1989 Session Laws, as rewritten by Section 131 of Chapter 752 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 81. Effective January 1, 1990, the maximum monthly rate for ambulatory residents in domiciliary care facilities shall be ~~seven hundred twenty four dollars (\$724.00)~~ \$724.00 and the maximum monthly rate for semi-ambulatory residents shall be ~~seven hundred sixty dollars (\$760.00)~~ \$760.00. Effective January 1, 1991, the maximum monthly rates for ambulatory residents shall be increased to ~~seven hundred thirty four dollars (\$734.00)~~ \$830.00 and for semi-ambulatory residents ~~seven hundred seventy dollars (\$770.00)~~ \$866.00."

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of \$4,920,895 for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to fund the State share of the cost of this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
