1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION HONORING REPRESENTATIVE ROBERT C. HUNTER,
2 NEWLY ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF THE SOUTHERN LEGISLATIVE
3 CONFERENCE; JOHN YOUNG, RECIPIENT OF THE SAM CARTER AWARD;
4 THE HOUSE HOST COMMITTEE OF THE SOUTHERN LEGISLATIVE
5 CONFERENCE, AND LEGISLATIVE STAFF FOR THEIR WORK IN MAKING
6 THE 1990 SOUTHERN LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE AN OVERWHELMING
7 SUCCESS.

8 Whereas, the Southern Legislative Conference is an annual event that
9 provides an important regional forum for legislators and legislative staff from 15
10 southern states to consider common problems and issues, to exchange ideas and
11 information, and to enjoy the company and hospitality of fellow Southerners, a tradition
12 as old as the South itself; and

13 Whereas, the City of Asheville and County of Buncombe extended every
14 courtesy to those attending the 1990 Southern Legislative Conference and graciously
15 welcomed them to our State; and

16 Whereas, the members of the House Host Committee, Representative Jack
17 Hunt, Co-chair, and Representatives N. Jim Crawford, Julia C. Howard, Robert C.
18 Hunter, Howard Hunter, Jr., and Marty Kimsey did an outstanding job of coordinating
19 seminars that addressed a wide range of issues and planning social events and
20 recreational activities that showcased some of the State's most splendid and beautiful
21 cultural and natural resources; and

22 Whereas, Representative Robert C. Hunter is the newly elected Chairman of
23 the Southern Legislative Conference, a distinguished office that signifies long hours of

1 service, generous contributions of time and talent, the high esteem with which he is
2 regarded by his peers, and an honor that reflects proudly not only on Representative
3 Hunter but also on the House in which he serves and the State that he represents; and

4 Whereas, John H. Young, III, who has served the General Assembly as a
5 Human Resources Analyst in the General Research Division since 1975 and whose
6 professional expertise in the public health area, personal integrity, and willingness to
7 help are respected by legislators and staff, is the first recipient of the Southern
8 Legislative Conference's Sam Carter Award for demonstrated excellence and dedication
9 to legislative service; and

10 Whereas, because the splendid success of the Southern Legislative
11 Conference was possible only because of the efforts and hard work of many: George
12 Hall, Legislative Administrative Officer, and Beverly Adams, Administrative Assistant,
13 who spent countless hours arranging and rearranging conference plans and activities;
14 the legislative staff, who cheerfully and ably tended to the work that is essential to the
15 success of the conference; and those in the private sector, who were generous in their
16 support of this legislative effort; and

17 Whereas, the House of Representatives wishes to thank its own members who
18 attended the Southern Legislative Conference for their fine representation of North
19 Carolina and the warmth with which they welcomed their neighbors and guests to the
20 Old North State;

21 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

22 Section 1. The House of Representatives extends its congratulations to
23 Representative Robert C. Hunter in his new office as Chairman of the Southern
24 Legislative Conference.

25 Sec. 2. The House of Representatives extends its congratulations to John
26 Young, the first recipient of the Sam Carter Award and expresses its appreciation for the
27 work he has done.

28 Sec. 3. The House of Representatives expresses its gratitude to the members
29 of the House Host Committee of the Southern Legislative Conference and to the
30 legislative staff for the work they did to make the Southern Legislative Conference an
31 overwhelming success.
