A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF NEGLECTED CHILD WITHIN THE
JUVENILE JURISDICTION OF THE DISTRICT COURT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-517(21) reads as rewritten:

"(21) Neglected Juvenile. – A juvenile who does not receive proper care, supervision, or discipline from his parent, guardian, custodian, or caretaker; or who has been abandoned; or who is not provided necessary medical care or other remedial care recognized under State law, or who lives in an environment injurious to his welfare, or who lives in a home where another child dies under questionable circumstances or a home where another child is subjected to sexual abuse or severe physical abuse, or who has been placed for care or adoption in violation of law."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
