Section 1. G.S. 7A-659(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) The <u>court</u>, <u>judge</u>, after making findings of fact, shall <u>affirm the county</u> department's or child-placing agency's plans or require specific additional steps which are necessary to accomplish a permanent placement which is in the best interests of the <u>child</u>. have authority to make any disposition authorized by G.S. 7A-647, including the authority to place the child in the custody of either parent or any relative found by the court to be suitable. The court may enter an order continuing the placement under review or providing for a different placement as is deemed to be in the best interest of the juvenile. If at any time custody is restored to a parent, the court shall be relieved of the duty to conduct periodic judicial review of the placement."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
