1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL
3 MANAGEMENT COMMISSION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 143B-283(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) The Environmental Management Commission shall consist of 13 members
7 appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall select the members so that the
8 membership of the Commission shall consist of:

- 9 (1) One who shall be a licensed physician;
- 10 (2) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
11 the Commission for Health Services or local board of health or have
12 experience in health sciences; ~~have had experience in water and air~~
13 ~~pollution control activities;~~
- 14 (3) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
15 or have had experience in agriculture or agricultural sciences;
- 16 (4) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be a registered engineer
17 experienced in water supply or water or air pollution control; ~~the~~
18 ~~planning or conservation of water or air resources, or planning of water or~~
19 ~~sewer systems, or having experience in the field of industrial water supply or~~
20 ~~water and air pollution control, or have had practical experience in water~~
21 ~~supply and water and air pollution control problems of municipal~~
22 ~~government;~~

- 1 (5) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
2 or have had experience in the fish and wildlife conservation activities
3 of the State;
- 4 (6) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and
5 scientific expertise in groundwater hydrology or groundwater pollution
6 control; ~~be actively connected with or knowledgeable in the groundwater~~
7 industry;
- 8 (7) ~~Five~~ Three members interested in water and air pollution control,
9 appointed from the public at large;
- 10 (8) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
11 industrial production or have had experience in the field of industrial
12 air and water pollution control; ~~and~~
- 13 (9) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
14 or have had experience in pollution control problems of municipal or
15 county ~~government~~ government;
- 16 (10) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and
17 scientific expertise in the effects of air pollution and air pollution
18 control; and
- 19 (11) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and
20 scientific expertise in freshwater, estuarine, marine biological, or
21 ecological sciences."

22 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. However, Commission
23 members serving on the Environmental Management Commission on the date of
24 ratification shall be eligible to complete their respective terms.
