1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL
3 MANAGEMENT COMMISSION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 143B-283(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) The Environmental Management Commission shall consist of 13 members
7 appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall select the members so that the
8 membership of the Commission shall consist of:

9 (1) One who shall be a licensed ~~physician~~; physician with specialized
10 training and experience in the health effects of environmental
11 pollution;

12 (2) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
13 the Commission for Health Services or local board of health or have
14 experience in health sciences; ~~have had experience in water and air~~
15 ~~pollution control activities~~;

16 (3) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
17 or have had experience in agriculture;

18 (4) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be a registered engineer
19 experienced in with specialized training and experience in water supply
20 or water or air pollution control; ~~the planning or conservation of water or~~
21 ~~air resources, or planning of water or sewer systems, or having experience in~~
22 ~~the field of industrial water supply or water and air pollution control, or have~~

- 1 ~~had practical experience in water supply and water and air pollution control~~
2 ~~problems of municipal government;~~
- 3 (5) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
4 or have had experience in the fish and wildlife conservation activities
5 of the State;
- 6 (6) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and
7 scientific expertise in hydrogeology or groundwater hydrology; ~~or~~
8 ~~groundwater pollution control; be actively connected with or knowledgeable~~
9 ~~in the groundwater industry;~~
- 10 (7) ~~Five~~ Three members interested in water and air pollution control,
11 appointed from the public at large;
- 12 (8) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
13 industrial production or have had experience in the field of industrial
14 air and water pollution control; ~~and~~
- 15 (9) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with
16 or have had experience in pollution control problems of municipal or
17 county ~~government.~~ government;
- 18 (10) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and
19 scientific expertise in air pollution control and the effects of air
20 pollution; and
- 21 (11) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and
22 scientific expertise in freshwater, estuarine, marine biological, or
23 ecological sciences."

24 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. However, Commission
25 members serving on the Environmental Management Commission on the date of
26 ratification shall be eligible to complete their respective terms.
