A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TAMMY LYNN MEMORIAL
2 FOUNDATION, INC., FOR FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION.

4 Whereas, the Tammy Lynn Memorial Foundation, Inc., was incorporated in
5 July 1969; and

6 Whereas, the Tammy Lynn Memorial Foundation, Inc., has obtained a
7 Certificate of Need from the State of North Carolina to construct two 10-bed ICF/MR's
8 (Intermediate Care Facility for the Mentally Retarded); and

9 Whereas, the Tammy Lynn Memorial Foundation, Inc., will construct on
10 State-owned property two 10-bed ICF/MR's, a new commercial kitchen, a new
11 education facility and renovate two existing facilities for early childhood intervention
12 services, respite care services, therapeutic services and administrative offices; and

13 Whereas, this capital project will cost two million two hundred thousand
14 dollars (\$2,200,000) of which one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000)
15 will be paid by private, individual and corporate donors and foundation grants; and

16 Whereas, the completed project will save each year approximately two
17 hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) in State expenditures for operating
18 costs; and

19 Whereas, the Tammy Lynn Memorial Foundation, Inc., serves over 300
20 multi-handicapped and developmentally delayed people each year; and

21 Whereas, the Tammy Lynn Memorial Foundation, Inc., is committed to
22 providing quality services to multi-handicapped and developmentally delayed citizens
23 in their own community; Now, therefore,

1 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Tammy Lynn
3 Memorial Foundation, Inc., the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the
4 1989-90 fiscal year to assist in construction of two 10-bed ICF/MR's, a new education
5 facility, a new commercial kitchen and renovation of program and administrative offices
6 at the Tammy Lynn Center.

7 Sec. 2. This shall become effective July 1, 1989.
