1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO INCLUDE AN EMPLOYEE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO THE
3 MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE PERSONNEL COMMISSION.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 Section 1. G.S. 126-2(b) reads as rewritten:
6 "(b) The Commission shall consist of seven members who shall be
7 appointed by the Governor on July 1, 1965, or as soon thereafter as is practicable. Two
8 members of the Commission shall be chosen from employees of the State ~~jeet~~subject to
9 the provisions of this Chapter; two members shall be ~~appointed~~appointed, of which one
10 shall be an employee of local government subject to the provisions of this Chapter, from
11 a list of individuals nominated by the North Carolina association of county
12 commissioners; two members shall be individuals actively engaged in the management
13 of a private business or industry; and one member shall be appointed from the public at
14 large. Of the initial members of the Commission, two shall be appointed to serve for
15 terms of two years, two shall be appointed to serve for terms of four years, and three
16 shall be appointed to serve for terms of six years. Their successors shall be appointed
17 by the Governor for terms of six years. Any vacancy occurring prior to the expiration
18 of a term shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term."
19 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to appointments to
20 be made on and after that date.
