A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEW ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
AND GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES CENTER IN THE TOWN OF
ROBBINSVILLE.

Whereas, a new Economic Development and Governmental Services Center has been proposed for the Town of Robbinsville; and

Whereas, this new facility will serve the interests of Graham County, the Town of Robbinsville, and the Graham County Chamber of Commerce by providing much needed office space for each of these entities; and

Whereas, the new facility will be located and designed in such a way as to have a full-time Welcome Center to be staffed and operated by the Graham County Chamber of Commerce and administrative space to accommodate the Chamber's economic development functions; and

Whereas, the facility will provide job opportunities in Graham County, which has a chronically high unemployment rate; and

Whereas, funds are needed to construct this new facility; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Robbinsville, in Graham County, \$322,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the construction of a new Economic Development and Local Government Services Center, to serve the interests of Graham County, the Town of Robbinsville, and the Graham County Chamber of Commerce.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
