A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR RESIDENTIAL SETTINGS FOR
INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL
DISABILITIES.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Human Resources, \$1,654,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$1,848,680 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for 18 project sites awarded by HUD to the Association for Retarded Citizens/North Carolina, Inc., and one project site awarded to the United Methodist Agency for the Retarded of Western Carolina, to provide for start-up and pre-construction costs of 1988 HUD Fund Reservations for residential settings for adults with mental retardation and developmental disabilities.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
