A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE COMMISSION OF INDIAN AFFAIRS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina State Commission of Indian Affairs \$50,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used for a grant-in-aid to the Lumbee Regional Development Association, Incorporated, to complete the tribal enrollment process.

- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina State Commission of Indian Affairs \$50,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$50,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for a staff member to recruit business and industry to locate in or near the Indian communities in the State.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina State Commission of Indian Affairs \$47,177 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$48,411 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for a drug and substance abuse prevention counselor to implement a drug and substance abuse prevention program targeted specifically at the Indian communities in the State.
- Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina State Commission of Indian Affairs \$35,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for a grant-in-aid to the Robeson Historical Drama, Inc., which sponsors "Strike at the Wind" outdoor drama.
 - Sec. 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
