A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PLACE THE HIGHWAY DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION AS "NC 400" UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE  
ROANOKE VOYAGES AND ELIZABETH II COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 7 of Chapter 1194 of the 1981 Session Laws, as amended  
by Chapter 673 of the 1985 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"**Sec. 7.** The word 'highway' as used in this act means U.S. Highway 64 and 264 on  
Roanoke Island between the William B. Umstead Memorial Bridge over Croatan Sound  
and the Washington Baum Bridge over Roanoke Sound and the highway designated by  
the Department of Transportation as North Carolina 400 (NC 400)."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
