the 1990-91 fiscal year, for operating expenses.

1	Sec. 3. The North Carolina Center for the Study of Black History, Inc., shall
2	make an annual written report on the use of the funds appropriated in Section 2 on May
3	1 of each year, beginning in 1990.
4	Sec. 4. The Office of State Budget shall disburse the funds appropriated for
5	the 1989-90 fiscal year by August 1, 1989, and shall disburse the funds appropriated for
6	the 1990-91 fiscal year by August 1, 1990.
7	Sec. 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
