A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF A CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AT NORTH CAROLINA MEMORIAL
HOSPITAL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by North Carolina Memorial Hospital of an Administrative Office Building, in the amount of \$8,774,200, and to authorize the financing of this capital improvements project from funds available to the Hospital from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of funds, but not including funds appropriated from the General Fund of the State.

- Sec. 2. The project authorized to be constructed and financed as provided in Section 1 of this act is as follows:

- Sec. 3. The Director of the Budget, provided the Director of the Budget may consult with the Advisory Budget Commission, may, when in his opinion it is in the best interest of the State to do so, and upon the request of The University of North Carolina Board of Governors, authorize a decrease in the scope or a change in the method of funding of the project authorized by this act.
 - Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
