A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CHAPEL HILL-CARRBORO
BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ASSIST ITS PILOT PROJECT TO INCREASE
STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT, PARTICULARLY AMONG AT-RISK STUDENTS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Chapel Hill-Carrboro Board of Education \$50,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to support a pilot school with a restructured learning environment incorporating the most recent reform initiatives, with a goal of increasing student achievement, particularly among at-risk students.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
