## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED <br> AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT A NEW HEADQUARTERS AND TRAINING FACILITY, TO PROVIDE REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE, AND TO COVER PRINTING AND REPRODUCTION COSTS FOR THE CIVIL

 AIR PATROL.The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety $\$ 137,500$ for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$37,500 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for the North Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., to be allocated as follows:
(1) $\$ 100,000$ for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the construction by the North Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., of a new headquarters and training facility. No less than ninety percent ( $90 \%$ ) of these funds will be used for capital improvements, and the remaining ten percent (10\%) may be used for furnishings. In order to receive these funds, the North Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., must match the funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis; and
(2) $\$ 20,000$ for the 1989-90 fiscal year and $\$ 20,000$ for the $1990-91$ fiscal year for repairs and maintenance of aircraft; and
(3) $\$ 2,500$ for the $1989-90$ fiscal year and $\$ 2,500$ for the $1990-91$ fiscal year to cover the cost of printing and reproduction; and
(4) $\$ 10,000$ for the $1989-90$ fiscal year and $\$ 10,000$ for the 1990-91 fiscal year for cadet programs; and
(5) $\$ 5,000$ for the $1989-90$ fiscal year and $\$ 5,000$ for the $1990-91$ fiscal year for additional travel expenses.
Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
