7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 8 Crime Control and Public Safety \$137,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$37,500 for 9 the 1990-91 fiscal year for the North Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., to be 10 allocated as follows:

11	(1)	\$100,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the construction by the North
12		Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., of a new headquarters and
13		training facility. No less than ninety percent (90%) of these funds will
14		be used for capital improvements, and the remaining ten percent (10%)
15		may be used for furnishings. In order to receive these funds, the North
16		Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., must match the funds on a
17		dollar-for-dollar basis; and
18	(2)	\$20,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$20,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal
19		year for repairs and maintenance of aircraft; and

- 20(3)\$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$2,500 for the 1990-91 fiscal21year to cover the cost of printing and reproduction; and
- (4) \$10,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal
