A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT A NEW HEADQUARTERS
2 AND TRAINING FACILITY, TO PROVIDE REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE,
3 AND TO COVER PRINTING AND REPRODUCTION COSTS FOR THE CIVIL
4 AIR PATROL.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
8 Crime Control and Public Safety \$137,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$37,500 for
9 the 1990-91 fiscal year for the North Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., to be
10 allocated as follows:

- 11 (1) \$100,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the construction by the North
12 Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., of a new headquarters and
13 training facility. No less than ninety percent (90%) of these funds will
14 be used for capital improvements, and the remaining ten percent (10%)
15 may be used for furnishings. In order to receive these funds, the North
16 Carolina Wing of the Civil Air Patrol, Inc., must match the funds on a
17 dollar-for-dollar basis; and
18 (2) \$20,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$20,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal
19 year for repairs and maintenance of aircraft; and
20 (3) \$2,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$2,500 for the 1990-91 fiscal
21 year to cover the cost of printing and reproduction; and
22 (4) \$10,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal
23 year for cadet programs; and

- 1 (5) \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$5,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal
2 year for additional travel expenses.
3 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
