SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1171

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH
2 COMMISSION TO STUDY THE EFFECTS OF THE USE OF TOXIC
3 SUBSTANCES BY THE MEDICAL AND DENTAL PROFESSIONS ON THE
4 HEALTH OF PERSONS EXPOSED TO SUCH SUBSTANCES.

5 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study the
7 effects of the use of toxic substances by the medical and dental professions on the health
8 of persons exposed to such substances. In conducting the study, the Commission shall
9 identify the toxic substances most commonly and frequently used by the medical and
10 dental professions, such as regularly administered X rays and artificial substances used
11 in dental treatment, and the potentially harmful effects of long-term and short-term
12 exposure to such substances. The Legislative Research Commission may make an
13 interim report to the 1989 General Assembly, Regular Session 1990, and shall make a
14 final report to the 1991 General Assembly.

15 Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
