A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ESTABLISHING LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 166A-7(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Each county which establishes an emergency management agency pursuant to State standards and which meets requirements for local plans and programs may be eligible to receive State financial assistance. Such financial assistance for the maintenance and operation of a county emergency management program will not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for any fiscal year and is subject to an appropriation being made for this purpose. There is annually appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Emergency Management, Department of Crime Control and Public Safety, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to provide the State financial assistance pursuant to this subsection. Eligibility of each county will be determined annually by the State."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
