AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
COLLEGES FOR ROANOKE-CHOWAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO
CONSTRUCT AN INDUSTRIAL SKILLS TRAINING CENTER FOR THE
SHELTERED WORKSHOP.

5 Whereas, Roanoke-Chowan Industries, (Sheltered Workshop) was established 6 by the Roanoke-Chowan Community College Board of Trustees to provide vocational 7 evaluation, adjustment, and industrial skills job training for the emotionally, mentally, 8 and physically handicapped individuals of the Roanoke-Chowan area; and

9 Whereas, the Sheltered Workshop has experienced much success in recent 10 years, and was recognized by Vocational Rehabilitation, a primary contractor for its 11 services, for the exemplary services provided to clients by the Sheltered Workshop; and

Whereas, the potential for growth and the need for the services offered by the Sheltered Workshop continues but additional facilities are required to provide safe and professional skills training and production; Now, therefore,

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 17 Community Colleges for Roanoke-Chowan Community College \$175,000 for the 1989-18 90 fiscal year to construct an Industrial Skills Training Center for the Sheltered 19 Workshop which provides vocational evaluation, adjustment, and industrial training 20 skills job training for the emotionally, mentally, and physically handicapped individuals 21 in the Roanoke-Chowan area. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no local 22 funds are required to match this appropriation.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
