Short Title: First Step Farm For Women/Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE FIRST STEP FARM FOR WOMEN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) Unexpended funds appropriated to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Services, in Section 3 of Chapter 1086 of the 1987 Session Laws for the development of the First Step Farm for Women shall not revert but shall be carried forward to the 1989-90 fiscal year and be used to continue development of the First Step Farm for Women.

(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Services, \$354,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$208,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to be used by the Blue Ridge Center for Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services for the development and operation of the First Step Farm for Women.

Sec. 2. Section 1(a) of this act shall become effective June 30, 1989. Section 1(b) of this act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
