6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
8	section to read:
9	" <u>§ 115C-230.1. Accountability/Flexibility Program.</u>
10	(a) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall establish and implement an
11	accountability/flexibility model capable of being implemented in selected local school
12	administrative units by July 1, 1990, and in all local school administrative units by July
13	1, 1993. The model shall include annual improvement plans developed by the local
14	school administrative units, which plans shall include short-range and long-range goals
15	and strategies designed to achieve these goals.
16	(b) The model shall further contain local plans for monitoring the implementation
17	of the model in participating local school administrative units and assessing the impact
18	of model implementation in terms of improved learning.
19	(c) <u>Standards for monitoring should address such issues as reduction in dropouts</u> ,
20	improvement in attendance, improvement in grades, improvement in test scores and
21	such other output indicators as are determined to be useful.
22	(d) Fiscal flexibility should be achieved by accurately assessing the cost
23	effectiveness of the dollars spend for education, rather than placing emphasis on objects
24	and items of expenditure.
