A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A STUDY OF THE IMPACT OF  
KINDERGARTEN EDUCATION ON SUBSEQUENT SCHOOL  
PERFORMANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina \$24,900 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for a study of the impact of kindergarten education on subsequent school performance. The study shall be carried out by the Collegium for the Advancement of Schools, Schooling, and Education at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. The Board of Governors shall report the results of the study to the General Assembly prior to May 1, 1990.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
