May 10, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO STUDY THE PROBLEMS OF DRUG TRAFFICKING AND 3 4 DRUG USE WITHIN THE STATE'S SCHOOL SYSTEM AND DETERMINE THE REASONS FOR THESE PROBLEMS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education the sum of \$200,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for a study to be conducted by the Superintendent of Public Instruction in three counties and one city with a population of between 70,000 and 150,000 persons to determine the main reason for drug trafficking and drug use within the State's school system.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
