Section 1. Rule 19 of the Permanent Senate Rules for the 1989 Session, as contained in Senate Resolution 143 adopted on March 20, 1989, reads as rewritten:

"RULE 19. **Motion; order of precedence.**—When a question is before the Senate no motion shall be received except those herein specified, which motions shall have precedence as follows:

- 12 (1) To adjourn.
- 13 (2) To suspend a rule of the Senate.
- (2) (3) To lay on the table.
- 15 $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ For the previous question.
- 16 (4) (5) To postpone indefinitely.
- 17 $\frac{(5)}{(6)}$ To postpone to a certain day.
- $\frac{(6)}{(7)}$ To commit to a standing committee.
- 19 $\frac{7}{8}$ (8) To commit to a select committee.
- (8) (9) To amend.
- 21 (9) (10) To substitute."
