1 A SENATE RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE
2 SENATE FOR THE 1989 SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 NORTH CAROLINA TO ESTABLISH THAT THE MOTION TO SUSPEND THE
4 RULES FOLLOW THE MOTION TO ADJOURN IN THE ORDER OF
5 PRECEDENCE OF MOTIONS.

6 Be it resolved by the Senate:

7 Section 1. Rule 19 of the Permanent Senate Rules for the 1989 Session, as
8 contained in Senate Resolution 143 adopted on March 20, 1989, reads as rewritten:

9 "RULE 19. **Motion; order of precedence.**—When a question is before the Senate no
10 motion shall be received except those herein specified, which motions shall have
11 precedence as follows:

12 (1) To adjourn.

13 (2) To suspend a rule of the Senate.

14 ~~(2)~~ (3) To lay on the table.

15 ~~(3)~~ (4) For the previous question.

16 ~~(4)~~ (5) To postpone indefinitely.

17 ~~(5)~~ (6) To postpone to a certain day.

18 ~~(6)~~ (7) To commit to a standing committee.

19 ~~(7)~~ (8) To commit to a select committee.

20 ~~(8)~~ (9) To amend.

21 ~~(9)~~ (10) To substitute."
