A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the current availability of medical services for all State law enforcement personnel, and determine whether the establishment of a centralized medical staff and equipment would be more cost effective than the current contractual arrangements.

- Sec. 2. The Commission may call upon all State departments and agencies that have administrative responsibilities for State law enforcement personnel and the Department of Human Resources, Division of Health Services, to cooperate with its study of medical services. The heads of the State departments or agencies shall ensure that staff cooperate fully with the Commission.
- Sec. 3. The Commission may make a final report to the 1989 General Assembly, Regular Session 1990.
 - Sec. 4. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
