1 A SENATE RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE UNITED STATES MARINE
2 CORPS AND THE UNITED STATES ARMED SERVICES FOR THEIR
3 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE
4 WORLD, AND IN PARTICULAR TO THE PEOPLE OF NORTH CAROLINA.

5 Whereas, the United States Marine Corps and the United States Armed
6 Forces are a fighting force without equal; and

7 Whereas, the United States Marine Corps and the United States Armed
8 Forces have always protected and defended not only the people and concerns of the
9 United States but have protected and defended freedom and democracy throughout the
10 world; and

11 Whereas, United States military history is a string of successes without equal
12 in the history of the world; and

13 Whereas, the high standards and commitment to excellence of the United
14 States Marine Corps and the United States Armed Forces give the United States
15 unequalled strength in the world community; and

16 Whereas, the reputation of the United States Marine Corps and the United
17 States Armed Forces make United States foreign policy a policy of confidence in
18 strength; and

19 Whereas, the citizens of North Carolina can feel secure in the knowledge that
20 they are protected by the finest fighting force on earth; and

21 Whereas, the citizens of North Carolina are proud that this State hosts some
22 of the nation's most elite military installations, including Camp Lejeune, Pope Air Force
23 Base, Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, and Fort Bragg; and

24 Whereas, military personnel within our State have made and continue to
25 make significant contributions to the economic vitality of the State; and

1 Whereas, military personnel have traditionally been and continue to be some
2 of our State's finest citizens and the very backbone of their communities;

3 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Senate:

4 Section 1. The Senate commends the United States Marine Corps and the
5 United States Armed Services for their contributions to the people of the United States
6 and to all the people of the world, and in particular to the people of North Carolina.

7 Sec. 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to
8 the United States Marine Corps and the United States Armed Services.

9 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
