A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL
INSTRUCTIONAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education the sum of \$1,500,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to provide video and other instructional equipment to support instructional programs as specified in the Basic Education Program and to provide video equipment to support teachers in their daily teaching duties. The Department of Public Education shall use these funds to ensure that all high schools with an average daily membership of 750 or less have a master antenna television system for instructional purposes. In addition to the master antenna television system, the General Assembly intends that basic instructional video equipment will be available for each classroom in the schools affected.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
