A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE PENDER COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
2 SHALL TAKE OFFICE ON THE FIRST DAY OF JULY FOLLOWING ITS
3 ELECTION.
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5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Effective January 1, 1992, G.S. 115C-37(d) reads as rewritten:

7 "(d) Members to Qualify. – Each county board of education shall hold a meeting
8 in ~~December~~ July following the election. At that meeting, newly elected members of the
9 board of education shall qualify by taking the oath of office prescribed in Article VI,
10 Sec. 7 of the Constitution.

11 This subsection shall not have the effect of repealing any local or special acts
12 relating to boards of education of any particular counties whose membership to said
13 boards is chosen by a vote of the people."

14 Sec. 2. The terms of office of members of the Pender County Board of
15 Education which began in 1988 and 1990 in accordance with Section 5 of Chapter 976,
16 Session Laws of 1983, shall terminate at the meeting of the Board in July of 1992 and
17 1994, respectively, at which their successors are, under G.S. 115C-37(d), to take the
18 oath of office.

19 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
