A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE DOMICILIARY HOME RATES AND TO
2 APPROPRIATE FUNDS.
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4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Section 81 of Chapter 500 of the 1989 Session Laws, as rewritten
6 by Section 131 of Chapter 752 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

7 "Sec. 81. Effective January 1, 1990, the maximum monthly rate for ambulatory
8 residents in domiciliary care facilities shall be ~~seven hundred twenty-four dollars (\$724.00)~~
9 \$724.00 and the maximum monthly rate for semi-ambulatory residents shall be ~~seven~~
10 ~~hundred sixty dollars (\$760.00)~~\$760.00. Effective January 1, 1991, the maximum
11 monthly rates for ambulatory residents shall be increased to ~~seven hundred thirty-four~~
12 ~~dollars (\$734.00)~~\$830.00 and for semi-ambulatory residents ~~seven hundred seventy dollars~~
13 ~~(\$770.00)~~\$866.00."

14 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social
15 Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of \$4,920,895 for the 1990-91
16 fiscal year, to fund the State share of the cost of this act.

17 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
