2 AN ACT TO ALLOW ADDITIONAL RETROACTIVE MEMBERSHIP IN THE 3 NORTH CAROLINA FIREMEN'S AND RESCUE SOUAD WORKERS'

3 NORTH CAROLINA FIREMEN'S AND RESCUE SQUAD WORKERS'
4 PENSION FUND.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 58-86-45 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 58-86-45. Additional retroactive membership.

Any fireman or rescue squad worker who is now eligible and is a member of 8 (a) a fire department or rescue squad chartered by the State of North Carolina and who has 9 not previously elected to become a member may make application through the board of 10 trustees for membership in the fund on or before March 31, 19871991. The person shall 11 make a lump sum payment of five dollars (\$5.00) per month retroactively to the time he 12 first became eligible to become a member, plus interest at an annual rate of eight 13 percent (8%), for each year of his retroactive payments. Upon making the lump sum 14 payment, the person shall be given credit for all prior service in the same manner as if 15 he had made application for membership at the time he first became eligible. Any 16 member who made application for membership subsequent to the time he was first 17 eligible and did not receive credit for prior service may receive credit for this prior 18 service upon lump sum payment of five dollars (\$5.00) per month retroactively to the 19 time he first became eligible, plus interest at an annual rate of eight percent (8%), for 20 21 each year of his retroactive payments. Upon making this lump sum payment, the date of membership shall be the same as if he had made application for membership at the 22 time he was first eligible. Any fireman or rescue squad worker who has applied for 23 prior service under this subsection shall have until October 1, 1989, 1993, to pay for this 24

1 prior service and, if this payment is not made by October 1, 1989, 1993, he shall not 2 receive credit for this service.

3 Effective April 1, 1987, 1991, any fireman or rescue squad worker who has (b)not reached his thirty-fifth birthday who is eligible and who has not previously elected 4 to become a member may make application through the board of trustees for 5 6 membership in the fund at any time. The person shall make a lump sum payment of 7 five dollars (\$5.00) per month retroactively to the time he first became eligible to 8 become a member, plus interest at an annual rate to be set by the board of trustees, for 9 each year of his retroactive payments. Upon making this lump sum payment, the person 10 shall be given credit for all prior service in the same manner as if he had made application for membership at the time he first became eligible. Any member who has 11 12 not reached his thirty-fifth birthday who made application for membership subsequent 13 to the time he was first eligible and did not receive credit for prior service may receive 14 credit for such prior service upon lump sum payment of five dollars (\$5.00) per month 15 retroactively to the time he first became eligible, plus interest at an annual rate to be set 16 by the board of trustees, for each year of his retroactive payments. Upon making this 17 lump sum payment, the date of membership shall be the same as if he had made 18 application for membership at the time he was first eligible. Any fireman or rescue 19 squad worker who applies for prior service under this subsection shall have six months 20 from the date of his application to pay for this prior service and if the payment is not 21 made within that time he shall not receive credit for the prior service." Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
