A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE JURISDICTION OF THE MONROE ABC LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The third sentence of Chapter 541 of the 1963 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 165 of the 1965 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"The person or persons so appointed shall, after taking the oath prescribed by law for peace officers, have the same powers and authorities within ~~Union County~~ the city limits of the City of Monroe as other peace officers or the Board may contract for law enforcement pursuant to G.S. 18B-501(f)."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
