**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A  
RESIDENTIAL STATE PARK RANGER TRAINING CENTER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the purpose of establishing a residential training center to improve the professional skills and capabilities of State Park superintendents, rangers, and support staff.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
