- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the 7 sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the 8 purpose of establishing a residential training center to improve the professional skills 9 and capabilities of State Park superintendents, rangers, and support staff.

10 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
