**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR STAFF AND SUPPORT FOR A LAND SURVEYING TEAM TO MARK THE BOUNDARIES OF THE STATE PARKS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of fifty-nine thousand one hundred forty-four dollars (\$59,144) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of fifty-nine thousand one hundred forty-four dollars (\$59,144) for the 1990-91 fiscal year for the purpose of providing two land surveyors and support to mark and blaze the boundaries of the 140,000 acre State Parks System.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
