The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of nineteen thousand one hundred seventy-five dollars (\$19,175) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to provide office and equipment support for the State trails coordinator and four regional trails specialists as they work with volunteer groups around the State who are actively building and maintaining trails.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
