A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT MOST STUDENTS ENROLLED IN GRADES TWELVE
OR LESS FROM WORKING LATE ON SCHOOL NIGHTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 95-25.5 is amended by adding a new subsection after
subsection (a) to read:

"(a1) During the regular 10-month school term, no youth under 18 years of age
who is enrolled in school in grade 12 or less may be employed between 11 p.m. and 5
a.m. when there is school for the youth the next day."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective August 15, 1989.
