January 19, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SERVE MEMBERS OF THE WILLIE M. CLASS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education the sum of two million twenty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$2,028,138) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of two million twenty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$2,028,138) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to

Public Education the sum of two million twenty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$2,028,138) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of two million twenty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$2,028,138) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to serve members of the class identified in the case initially named Willie M., et al. vs. Hunt, et al., and currently named Willie M., et al. vs. Martin, et al., by increasing the support staff in school systems serving members of that class and by increasing funds going to school systems serving members of that class.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
